### **Dangerous and inconsiderate parking and driving**

Please remember that if you have to drive your child to School you should park with due consideration to others; in particular, do not block driveways. We have had several complaints from our neighbours, some of whom are High March parents, about dangerous parking which partially blocks their driveways and obscures their view of the road. Perhaps consider how you would feel if it was dangerous to try to leave your driveway.

We shall continue our policy of numbering and shaming repeat persistent offenders.

We also request parents of Sunday netball players NOT to park in the Beaconsfield Dental Practice car park. This is private property and includes a residential flat on the premises.
