### **New proposed Local Town Plan**

The existing Local Plan (which contains planning policies which govern what can and can't be built) is going to be replaced. This is very important for the town, not least because we can quote policies from the Local Plan when we want to object to or comment on planning applications.

SBDC are running a public consultation from now until 5pm on 14 March. You can have your say about what you want to see in the new Local Plan by completing the Response Form on the SBDC website - these forms should also be available in Beaconsfield library. This is an important public issue as the new Local Plan will govern planning policy until 2036. Suggestions could be that there are too many flats; we need safeguards for basement conversions, to protect space between houses so there is no cramming, to protect density of housing and the character of our woodland roads. In fact, whatever issues are important to you.

There is a public meeting concerning this at the Town Hall on **5 February at 7:30pm.**

BCP has secured agreement from the Town Council for the installation of further cycle racks in Beaconsfield. The next meeting of BCP will take place on **1 February 2016 at Junior House at 8pm.**
