



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Developing

- Sharing and turn taking skill-devise games to encourage this in outdoor play as well as indoor play.
- Showing respect and sensitivity.

Physical Development

Developing

- Counting in sequence.
- Fine motor co-ordination, especially in relation to clothing (doing up buttons, putting on shoes, putting on own clothes and dressing up-clothes).
- Independence- putting on coats, shoes and boots.
- Hopping and skipping.

Communication and Language

Developing

- Listening skills – story, each other. Build up confidence in speaking in a group situation. Learning new vocabulary re the topics.
- Using books which relate to topics to find information.
- Songs and rhymes.

Literacy

Developing

- Learning phonic sounds. Phases 1/2
- Knowing that print carries meaning and in English is read from left to right.

Mathematics

Developing

- Counting in sequence.
- 1:1 correspondence.
- Look at numbers 1- 5, recognition, and concept of a given number.
- Shape recognition and snowflakes.
- Number rhymes
- Sorting

Understanding the World

Developing

- Observational skills – use of magnifying glasses.
- Use globe and books to find out.
- Children (small groups) go to office to take messages.

Expressive Arts and Design

Developing

- Opportunities to paint, draw, cut, stick, print, design, make, observe.
- Role play – set up a shop.
- Act out story Chinese New Year & Rainbow Fish
- Music – listening, moving, singing, rhythm, percussion.
